Community Service Hours

The Grove School Community Service Program is designed to provide adolescents with the opportunity to become contributing members of their society and communities.

The goals of the program include:

- **To offer students the experience of providing meaningful service for the “greater good of all”.**
- **To give students the opportunity to grow in leadership.**
- **To show students, first hand, that their participation with their positive difference in their communities.**
- **To offer students the opportunity to become better citizens and to see themselves as contributing members of society.**

Community service assignments may vary depending on each student’s area of interest, transportation and the availability of sites in need of service. Some successful service commitments of the past have included:

- **The Salvation Army**
- **Redlands Family Services**
- **Humane Society**
- **San Bernardino County Forest Service**
- **Local homeless shelters**
- **The Grove School**
- **Church groups**
- **Scout groups**

In order to receive credit for this program, each student must complete a Community Service Form. All information must be filled out. When the hours have been completed, every student must **MAKE A PHOTOCOPY** of the form for themselves and **TURN IN THE ORIGINAL TO THE HIGH SCHOOL OFFICE**. Farm students must also turn in a copy to their mentor.

If a student completes more than the required 30 hours in a year they are **NOT** able to carry over the extra hours to the next year for credit. 30 hours of service must be completed for each and every year.
