

- A result of student being on probation and suspension and following a two week period unable to meet the grade requirements.
- A result of student being on suspension for a two week period and unable to meet the grade requirements after a two week period of suspension
- All uniforms and/or equipment **MUST** be returned to the Athletic Director no later than one week after removal from team.
- Failure to do so will result in a charge for the uniform and/or equipment.

1 The Grove School's number one priority is the student's academics. These guidelines are to ensure that the main goal is being met at all times.

Participation Responsibilities

- 1) Excessive unexcused absences or tardiness (as defined by the coach) will result in removal from the team.
- 2) Coaches must have prior knowledge of all absences. This includes any event that calls for a partial practice.
- 3) It is expected that each athlete demonstrate the highest level of sportsmanship as defined in the athletes' code of ethics form at all times. Please remember that as a member of the team you are representing your school.
- 4) Any damage to the athlete's assigned uniform beyond normal wear and tear will be the responsibility of the athlete. It will be expected that each athlete reimburse SOAR for any damaged uniform.

1 Participating in a school sport requires a daily commitment for approximately three months. Each athlete must be prepared to make this serious time commitment. Your team is counting on you.

Fundraising Responsibilities

- 1) Every athlete must participate in two out of three fundraisers held throughout the season. It will be the responsibility of the team, as a whole, to decide what fundraisers will be carried out.
